Bradlee spent 25 years with the Boston Globe and as deputy managing editor oversaw its Pulitzer Prize-winning coverage of the sexual abuse scandal in the Catholic Church from July 2001 to August 2002. John Slattery portrayed Bradlee Jr. in the 2015 Oscar winning film Spotlight.



Ben Fountain | Author Author of Brief Encounters with Che Guevara and Billy Lynn's Long Halftime Walk. Billy Lynn was adapted into a feature film directed by three-time Oscar winner Ang Lee. His series of essays published in The Guardian on the 2016 U.S. presidential election was subsequently nominated for the Pulitzer Prize in Commentary.

Albom's books have collectively sold more than thirty-nine million copies in forty-two languages.
